GUIDELINES ON REGISTRATIONS

1. Certificate of Registration and Pedigree

- **Registration Number**: Your cat's registration number is displayed on the top right, beginning with the letter '(V)'.
- Membership Number: Your profile/member's number is shown on the bottom left next to "Owner," beginning with 'V'.

2. Breeder's Prefix Registration

If you wish to enter the fascinating world of breeding cats, you will need to:-

Fill out and submit the form: 'Application for Breeder Prefix'

- The Office will check its records and also with other interstate associations to ensure the name requested does not already exist.
- It will take approximately 3 4 weeks to finalise the application.
- Your prefix can have a maximum of 12 letters.
- You can provide at least 5 names on the application if your first choice is unavailable.
- Fees for applications are as listed on the Prefix Application form.

3. Litter / Kitten Registration

- The owner of STUD CAT will need to fill out the form: 'Application for Litter/Kitten Registration'
 and pass it on to you
- When the litter is born, you will need to complete the rest of the form
 - The form allows you to register the kittens individually.
 - The registration fee is indicated at the bottom of the form
 - Even if you only register the litter, each kitten must be listed on the form, including their sex, breed, colour, and microchip number.
 - o You will receive a *Certificate of Registration and Pedigree* for all kittens individually named and registered.
 - You may include the new owner's details to have the Certificate directly send to them by the Office.

4. Transfer of Ownership of Cat/Kitten

- When the cat/kitten is transferred to another owner, the transfer facility is on the back of the Certificate of Registration and Pedigree.
- There is no separate transfer form for fully registered Cats/Kittens.
- Fill in the new owner's details on the back of the *Certificate of Registration and Pedigree* and return it to the office with the associated fees listed on the Certificate.

5. Show Cat Title Registration

When your cat has been awarded with Challenge Certificates (For entire cats), or Awards of Merits (for desexed cats), you may register Championship / Premier titles for your cat:

- Fill out and submit the form: 'Application for Championship / Premiership Title'
 - o With the required below to the Office by drop-off during the Office's opening hours or by post:
 - required certificates for that title application
 - ORGINAL COPY of Certificate of Registration and Pedigree
 - Application Fee
 - Please let the registrar know if you wish to have the Challenge Certificates / Awards of Merits cards returned.
- There must be a minimum of TWO FCCV Certificates/Awards. The new title must be processed before you can use it.
- If your cat qualifies after the close of entries, you must advise the Show Manager on the update as soon as the application has been sent to the FCCV Office.
